Footnotes

GLENWICK was rated while racing along the rail to the second turn, angled out, bid five wide and closed steadily to get up in the final strides. CAMP VERDE stalked outside, moved up along the backstretch, challenged on the far turn, inched away for a short lead at the top of the lane, led to deep stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. RATON PASS saved ground, got through along the rail on the turn, bid willingly but didn't have enough late. POET'S COVE saved ground to the second turn, bid seven wide at the top of the stretch, bid but also didn't have enough late. LIMITED WILL stalked the pace, went five wide leaving the turn and lacked the needed late response. OLYMPIC CHIEF raced in the middle of the pack, went six wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. GUMMY RUNNER was sent to the front to set the pace to the second turn, responded when challenged to duel, weakened in the drive and fell back. NOT OPPOSED stalked the pace, tired into the second turn and faded from contention. PARTNERSHIP PAYOUT raced wide to the second turn, failed to respond and was outrun.
