Footnotes

HAITIAN was unhurried early, angled out on the far turn, bid five wide, closed willingly and drew clear late in a driving finish. NO LAUGHING MATTER stalked the pace, challenged for the lead on the second turn, dueled past the sixteenth pole and was no match late. DAWN RAIDER lagged early, rallied inside on the turn, bid willingly but didn't have enough late. LIDGETTIMATE HEAT set the pace, responded when challenged to duel past the eighth pole but was unable to sustain his bid. ALERT N WISE raced mid pack, went four wide entering the stretch, bid and hung. THREE PARK NIGHT was unhurried early, advanced along the rail on the turn, angled out, bid six wide and failed to gain. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE was unhurried early, went seven wide in the drive and lacked the needed rally. RIO TORRE broke out, stalked inside to the stretch and flattened out. BORN A LEGEND broke awkwardly and was crowded at the start, raced close to the pace to the turn and tired. R HONOUR AND OBEY vied two across to the turn, tired and steadily faded from contention.
