GREEN SECRET stalked the pace inside, awaited room on the turn, angled in, bid between horses, assumed command, inched clear and held well. ONE CALL stalked the pace, rallied four wide on the turn, couldn't gain on the winner and was all out for second. C S I IOWA was unhurried early, went five wide entering the stretch, couldn't gain and was outnodded for place. ELUSIVE PLEASURE advanced inside to get within striking distance and hung. SUMMERTIME SAL raced mid pack in an even effort and failed to rally. SKYSPY vied two across to the second turn, weakened and faded through the stretch. SKIMASCO was never far back, went six wide in the drive and lacked a bid. BEARS HOME RUN fell back early, trailed the field and passed a tiring rival. DON'T DEFY ME vied inside to the second turn, tired and gave way.
