WARREN'S CANDY well placed early, advanced outside on the final turn and reached the front at the top of the lane then drew off, a driving winner. SHEISAFINELASS trailed early, awaited briefly for a clear path along the rail in upper stretch then finished well for the place. FATOULS GOLD saved ground to the far turn and gained some late outside. COMET DUST moved to the front from between rivals on the final turn, vied to the lane and weakened in the drive. MANZERITA raced wide into the lane and lacked a bid. CELESTIAL FORCE four wide early, chased and tired through the lane. HOLLYWOOD MOOD set the early pace and had little left entering the stretch.
