PROXYMAN set a pressured pace to the turn, drew clear and extended his lead while kept to task. ARTIC FIRE raced close to the pace, saved ground, got through along the rail on the turn, closed steadily and got up for place. VIA VERDE raced outside early, challenged three across on the turn, fell back, hung late and was outfinished for second. KING OF THE SKY was rated back at the start to trail the field, rallied around the turn, bid six wide but didn't have enough left. STORMY CANUCK was never far back while racing between horses, went five wide at the top of the lane and lacked a rally. MASTER DEMAND pressed the pace, challenged between horses on the turn and faltered. SAINTLY AURA showed good early speed while racing in hand, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid under mild urging.
