FILLE FILLY FIFI was unhurried in the second flight, rallied into the second turn, challenged three wide entering the stretch, dueled through the lane and narrowly prevailed. SPECTACULAR FLIGHT pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the far turn, dueled through the stretch and just missed in a game effort. BALBOA PARK was well placed inside, eased out for the drive and gained ground late under steady urging. HIGH PROMISE got away well, saved ground, angled out on the turn but lacked the needed late response. ALISON (MEX) was hustled to the front to set the pace, responded on the far turn to duel for the lead and yielded past the eighth pole. STRATTER offered a mild bid only and failed to threaten. VIRTUAL went a bit wide entering the stretch but lacked a serious bid. DRAG TIME GAL was through after a half. GENERAL COUNSEL failed to threaten.
