Footnotes

TONES (IRE) stalked the pace, challenged two wide on the second turn, dueled past the eighth pole and drew off under mild urging. ARRAIGNMENT set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled to mid stretch but was no match late. CHISENAU raced in hand along the rail around the first turn, saved ground, bid willingly, couldn't gain ground and was all out for show. KISS MY KRISS held a good position but lacked the needed late response. GRANDPA ROY was unhurried early, offered a mild bid only and failed to menace. SALADO TRIBE lagged early, got through along the rail on the second turn and lacked a bid. FLY'N LION was not a factor. BATTLE SCHOOL was in tight on the first turn, angled out, raced close to the pace outside but had nothing left for the drive.
