HEAVENLY RANSOM moved up between rivals on the backstretch, raced outside into the lane, responded gamely and powered clear late. SHESA PRIVATE I saved ground while setting the pace, responded gamely in the drive but could not contain the top one. KICK THE CAN between rivals into the far turn, raced just off the inside rounding the last turn, eased out slightly and offered a mild stretch bid. PLEASE DON'T TELL chased from just off the inside and weakened in the drive. VELOCISTA saved ground into the far turn, moved out some and lacked the needed response. FUZDAISY saved ground while close up early and weakened through the lane. LYNDEE'S PEARL a bit wide early, moved up outside on the backstretch, raced four deep into the far turn and tired. PAMELA DENISE chased early, raced between rivals and weakened rounding the final turn.
