Footnotes

LYMA BREEZE saved ground to the lane, moved out for the drive and finished gamely to prevail. MEGGIE'S LEGACY pulled early then was steadied along in traffic, leaned on and bumped with a rival in the run to the turn, raced outside on the bend and was six wide into the lane then finished gamely. FANNYTASTIC four wide into the turn reached the front between foes on the bend, battled and stayed on willingly to the end. CLOSING PASSAGE veered out at the start, raced five wide into the turn, battled head and head for the lead in midstretch then weakened late. CAPTURED HEART saved ground and vied for the lead then weakened late. SISTER SHADOW raced along the inside turning for home and lacked the needed bid. ANDY LAURA WILL was leaned on and bumped racing in tight quarters approaching and into the turn then had little left entering the lane. FIFTY K vied for the lead through the early stages, chased on the turn and tired. ATLANTA BLUE trailed and was eased on the turn then vanned off. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the run approaching the turn prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
