VISIBLE MARQ was checked entering the first turn, raced wide along the backstretch, dropped inside, angled back out on the second turn, bid six wide, closed willingly, assumed command past the eighth pole, drew clear and was ridden out. BESPOKE SUIT rallied five wide on the second turn and earned place under steady left handed urging. END OF DISCUSSION raced close to the pace, challenged three across into the turn, dueled past the eighth pole and was unable to sustain his bid. MACHO QUITO stalked the pace, challenged between horses into the second turn, dueled past the eighth pole and stopped. RALPHIE' OLE' was outrun. BOLD ESSENCE was away alertly to set the pace, tired into the second turn and gave way.
