VERNON CAT was washy during the warm-up, dueled on the outside, battled with VIMANA into the final furlong, edged clear approaching the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. HOLY BUCKETS was sent hard from the start, chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and finished willingly for the place. VIMANA dueled on the inside of the winner, lost touch with that rival inside the furlong marker and weakened while clear for the show. THISONESFORH'ARD was last away, raced well off the pace, went four wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail and failed to threaten. AMEN BABY bumped with a rival at the start, brushed with MR. CHUCK in the vicinity of the half-mile pole, went three then four wide on the turn and came up empty. MR. CHUCK was urged along on the outside, brushed with AMEN BABY near the half-mile pole, went four then three wide on the turn and had nothing left. GIFTED CRUSADER bumped with a rival at the start, dropped well behind while hard ridden and trailed.
