I'M MAKIN NOTES was just off the leaders into the turn, lodged her bid between foes mid way on the turn, bid again outside the leader in the final sixteenth and wore that one down for the score. QUALITY TOCS took the lead early, turned back a bid midway on the turn, widened again at mid stretch then gave ground grudgingly in the final strides. DOUBLE TRICKSTER broke a bit awkwardly, raced between foes into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and finishing willingly. HARMONY N EXCESS forced the pace while three wide, lodged her bid midway on the turn while still three wide, fell back into the stretch and tired. NORTHEAST ABBIE lacked any speed, was three wide into the drive and lacked a solid bid. ABOUT ME was taken off the rail near the five-eighths marker and was four wide into the turn, raced five wide on the turn and lacked a rally. LET'S DO THIS moved to the rail near the five-eighths marker, saved ground on the turn, stayed on the rail for the drive and tired. CHOCOLATE AFFAIR was slow into stride after the start, saved ground on the turn and stopped in the drive.
