GRANDPA ROY rated off the pace along the inside, found an opening along the rail turning into the stretch, stayed on the rail for the drive, finished well and finished in a dead-heat for the win. STEEL BLUE set all the pace, responded when challenged late and finished on even terms for the win. FATHER JONES was just off the leader along the rail, came out for the drive while five wide, finished willingly but not enough late. ST PATRICKS APPEAL forced the pace, lodged his bid nearing the quarter pole then weakened late. TWO TURNS fell back after the start, was six wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. JOE BLACK SANDY broke a bit awkwardly, reached contention down the backstretch, took the two path into the stretch and tired.
