Footnotes

HIDDEN HARBOR set all the pace, was rated on the lead then drew off under a hand ride through the drive while not feeling the whip. OPTIMISTIC BULLET (BRZ) forced the pace from along the rail, stayed inside for the stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. TRAPPERS STAR broke in and bumped a rival at the start, swung seven wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. LIZA STORM was solidly bumped at the break, saved ground on the turn then stayed inside for the stretch while not seriously threatening. RAZOR BUCK forced the pace while three wide into the turn, stayed in contention to the stretch then tired. PURE ARTISTRY raced five wide on the turn then six wide into the drive while not a factor. EMERALD'S DIAMOND had a ground-saving trip but was not a threat. RAISINABOVEONLY was close to the pace from between foes to the turn, was five wide into the stretch and tired. ANGEL'S KEEP raced four to five wide down the backstretch, took the three path into the stretch and tired.
