Footnotes

STRAWBERRY ISLAND vied for the lead inside three horses into the turn, then dueled to the stretch, widened and was in hand the final furlong. BUDS N ROSES was four wide on the turn, took the three path into the stretch and earned the place. DIVA DOLLY vied between foes into the turn then dueled the winner to the stretch and weakened. TALE OF THE TIGER moved up inside off the leaders to nearing the stretch, stayed along the rail and weakened. SISTER SHADOW saved ground on the turn, took the two path into the stretch then drifted out late tiring. MOLLY'S RISK broke alertly and forced the pace from between foes down the backstretch but tired after a half. NOBLE RULE fell back after the start, was five wide into the stretch and never seriously threatened. MISS JEANINE broke a bit awkwardly and was four wide down the backstretch, was seven wide into the stretch while tiring.
