WAYNE MANOR drew clear on the turn and raced off the rail into the stretch, widened then maintained a safe margin. CLAIM THE THRONE raced near the inside on the turn, gradually moved to the rail leaving the eighth pole and was clear for the place. FIGHTING WONDER raced between rivals entering the turn, chased and lacked the needed late response. GONE GRAND pressed early inside and weakened in the drive. SILVER PLAN chased early three wide, raced four wide into the lane then came back on some late. HEATHER'S ECHO saved ground and lacked the needed response. RIBOT'S RIFT lacked a rally. CANELA TWIST failed to menace.
