LUCKY BOY NELSON three wide passing the half mile pole, drew clear on the turn, widened some into midstretch then lasted to the wire. ARIZONA WRANGLER bumped and forced out at the start, raced five wide into the lane and finished gamely. LYNNWOODSLEW bumped between rivals at the start, raced just off the inside on the turn, moved out and also finished gamely. IRISH SNOWFALL bumped at the start, advanced nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. CT. ORDERED BENDER broke outward causing crowding, saved ground to the lane and lacked the needed response. SWIFT BEN pressed early, chased on the turn and tired. IRONSIDES came wide to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DOUBLE BOOGIE broke in, vied early and weakened. DRIVING TUNES was bothered some at the start then lacked a response.
