C S I IOWA was reserved on the inside while towards the back, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, waited behind a rival while inside on the far turn, moved off the rail and was asked at the top of the stretch, came between rivals near the three-sixteenths pole, made a bid entering the final furlong, battled gamely with EVENING ISLAND, drifted out a bit when switched to a left-handed whip late and narrowly prevailed. EVENING ISLAND brushed with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled nicely behind the leading group, eased out a bit leaving the backstretch, chased three then four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, held a short lead past the eighth-pole, battled gamely with C S I IOWA in the final furlong and was denied. GRANDPA ROY settled on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, pursued the leaders into the final furlong, drifted out some shortly thereafter and finished willingly for the show while unable to match the top two. STEP ASIDE CLYDE went two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved at the back, moved closer while four then three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, moved in some during the drive and lacked the needed kick. KEEP ME POSTED went three wide on the first turn, tracked the leading duo on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished. FRANSOR'S FINEST was hustled to the lead then taken in hand, contested the pace on the inside, came under urging on the far turn and gave way. SUPERCARLS REMEDY contested the pace on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
