WINTER MEETING broke best from the gate, held a length advantage for the half, drifted six wide off the turn, and raced clear through the drive. WHITEGOLDNDIAMONDS stalked third down the backstretch, advanced to striking position around the turn, stalked close to the top of the lane, but proved no match for WINTER MEETING down the lane. BELLA CASH off the pace for the half, closed strongly late in the turn, came five wide to the head of the stretch, and showed as best of the rest. BY A MILE BABY last to the lane, responded well in the final furlong, and improved position to the wire. TROPHY EDITION TOO pressed the pace down the backstretch, yielded to the speed around the turn, and weakened in the drive. TRUCK STOP TRUDY was through after the half. TESSE JO faded while racing seven wide to the upper stretch. ASPEN HILL was not a factor in the outcome.
