MAJOR MAGIC raced close to the pace, dropped back along the backstretch, rallied around the turn, went eight wide at the top of the lane, closed willingly, got up past the sixteenth pole and drew clear. FABLE HAVEN was crowded at the start, was slow early, slowly advanced to the turn, bid seven wide and closed steadily to get up late for place. AZ RIDGE vied between horses, inched away for a short lead past the eighth pole, was outfinished in a game effort and lost position late. GALITZIANER challenged four across leaving the turn, bid willingly to loom a threat but didn't have enough late. WHY FRANK was slow early, rallied off the rail and closed through traffic in a good effort. MIGIWEWIN showed good early speed inside, fell back, came again along the rail on the turn and hung. BOCA BAY vied inside, faltered near the sixteenth pole and dropped back. THE GOV moved up along the backstretch to vie three across past the eighth pole and gave way. LOBO DEL DESIERTO was never far off the pace, lacked room on the turn and in the stretch and faded from contention. BORN FORCE was not a factor. CONGRATS SKI stalked outside, went four wide into the second turn, tired and gave way.
