MY JON JOHN moved up four wide into the backstretch and drew clear, showed the way to the lane then responded gamely in the drive and held a rival safe to the wire. WOLFGANG vied early between rival then raced up close and inside into the far turn, lodged a bid from the two path entering the lane and finished gamely. WESTERN STRIDER vied early stages while not being asked, gave ground down the backstretch, raced just off the rail entering the far turn, eased out in the stretch and gained some while earning the show. LOCALS ONLY saved ground and lacked the needed stretch bid. BITTER CREEK five wide to the backstretch, stayed outside and advanced some on the final turn then weakened in the drive. PROGRAM MANAGER four wide early, lodged a bid on the final turn and tired in the drive. WARDUTY lacked a rally. WANTED FOR CASH three wide on the clubhouse turn, raced forwardly placed to the far turn and weakened.
