FOREST MOUSE raced in the second flight between horses, went six wide entering the stretch, closed willingly, assumed command near the sixteenth pole and inched clear late. RIBAT raced close to the pace three across, challenged for the lead on the turn, got a head in front, led to deep stretch, was outclosed but held for place. WICKED LANDLORD was unhurried early, went seven wide entering the stretch, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough late. GOLDFIRE saved ground to the second turn, angled out for the drive, bid and hung. SILVER SENSATION fell far back early, went eight wide in the drive, offered a mild bid and gained position. BIG BLUE CABOOSE pressed the pace three across to the second turn, tired and gave way. CROWN KING set a pressured pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. CROWN OF ARAGORN pressed the pace between horses, tired into the turn and stopped.
