QUILCHENA PARK showed the way to the lane and gradually drew out, a driving winner. CHILLY WILLY broke a bit slowly, pressed from along the inside into the turn, moved out nearing the top of the lane and chased then held the place. GAHNZO BOB in just a bit close briefly at the start, raced outside on the turn then was gaining late. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM up close early, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. SILVER DAYBREAK moved inside on the turn and lacked a rally. LUCK OF THE DEVIL raced near the inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. LAST BLEND broke out some, raced near the rail and tired through the lane.
