OUR MAGIC COUPLE set the pace, drew off on the turn and extended his lead while being kept to task. PENTECOST was slow early while racing outside, went six wide at the top of the lane, closed under steady left handed urging and earned place while no threat to the winner. GLOBAL STORM bumped at the start, chased the pace, had little left for the drive, hung in the lane but held for show. SURFLINER held a good position inside, bid and came up empty. MUSTANG CASINO failed to respond. SUPER CANDY bumped at the start, trailed the field and failed to contend.
