TRIBAL WISH raced wide along the backstretch, went five wide leaving the turn, was in tight at the top of the lane, closed willingly and got up in the final strides. BALDESARRI was hustled along to set the pace, drew off into the turn, led to deep stretch and was outclosed. POPULAR NAME was never far off the pace, was in tight quarters entering the turn, bid, hung but held for show. REXBURG was in tight at the top of the lane and lacked the needed late response. WANDERABOUTYOU raced mid pack, saved ground, failed to rally and did not threaten. MIDNIGHT COCKTAIL pressed the pace inside, was through early and dropped back. STAR PACKER showed good early speed, was in tight quarters entering the turn, fell back and gave way. HAMPTON COURT was taken outside, trailed the field and showed little.
