DIAMOND DAN set the pace and held well in a driving finish. CAT'S GOLD stalked the pace, bid inside, lacked the needed late response and finished second best. JANZIG AFFAIR rallied around the turn, angled out for the drive and closed to get up near the wire for show. SCARY MIDNIGHT stalked the pace, went four wide leaving the turn, lacked the needed rally and was caught for third. QUICK MEETING was never far back, bid five wide and narrowed the gap. NYMEGEN PITA was void of early speed, had an uneven course in the stretch and finished well. PRESTONS PRIZE raced close to the pace inside and failed to rally. MONTENEGRIN raced wide early, dropped inside, bid along the rail but had little left for the drive. BEAR'S ALI had brief speed only. STRONG SUGGESTION broke slowly and was not a factor. BAILEY'S DYNASTY showed good early speed, fell back, went six wide leaving the turn and continued to fade. HAYDEN LAKE showed some early speed, went seven wide leaving the turn and gave way.
