TRIBAL DREAMS stalked the pace while racing inside, awaited room on the turn, eased out once clear, closed steadily to get up past the sixteenth pole and drew clear. A ROYAL TIZZY vied inside to the turn, inched away, led past the sixteenth pole and was outclosed to finish second best. BONBONI raced mid pack, rallied into the turn, drifted out through the stretch but earned show. GHOST RIDE was outrun in an even effort. TRIP THE GENERAL trailed the field, was crowded in late stretch and was not a factor. RAINIER MISSILE raced close to the pace, was carried out leaving the turn and gave way. SEE YA LATER SLEW vied two across, bore out on the turn, dropped back and was not urged thereafter.
