QUICK STEVIE raced near the rail into the lane and offered a mild stretch response. MEMO NUMBER FIVE raced in a bit close entering the lane then offered a belated gain. HIGH CLASS CAT broke in and bumped, vied for the lead through the opening stages, chased and lacked the needed stretch response. DR MACKEE saved ground and lacked the needed bid. MENTMORE saved ground and lacked a rally. STRIKER BEAN trailed early and lacked a rally. RUM AND EARL was outrun. UNDERSUSPICION chased early outside and tired. LITTLE DUDE bobbled at the start and bumped, chased and tired through the lane. MOM'S BALLETT was outrun and not urged late.
