PERKY STU S set the pace inside and responded to pressure while holding a rival safe. TWO ONE GUN advanced outside on the turn and finished willingly while second best. PERKINS moved four wide for the drive and offered a mild bid. ONERY DOLLARS raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. EXACTLY RIGHT reluctant loading, raced outside on the turn and lacked the needed bid. TWO POINT TONY chased while near the rail and tired in the drive. BRONZE BEAU was fractious briefly in the gate, trailed early then lacked a rally. SKY STALKER was fractious at the gate and ran loose briefly, saved ground and tired through the lane. NU POWER chased early and dropped back on the turn then was eased in the lane and vanned off.
