CANARD well placed near the rail, raced three wide passing the quarter pole and joined the leaders in midstretch then finished gamely to prevail. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER never far back and four wide nearing the top of the lane, finished gamely. BIG CITY BERNIE tracked early, moved closer on the final turn and battled into midstretch then was not good enough. CAPT. SPARROW lodged a bid inside on the final turn, raced off the rail into the stretch, was between rivals late and needed more. BEARS HOME RUN trailed early, saved ground and advanced inside into midstretch then lacked a clear path in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole. STONEWALL RIOT set the pace inside and weakened late. STORMY SEATTLE raced well placed into the far turn and weakened.
