MR. PADRE was hustled along to set the pace and held well under urging. SOUTHERN SCULPTOR was slow early, rallied around the turn, went nine wide entering the stretch, found his best stride late and got up near the wire for second. ARCTIC CEAL showed speed around the first turn, was rated back to stalk, bid willingly, couldn't gain on the winner and was caught for place. LOBO DEL DESIERTO was slow early, rallied off the rail leaving the turn but didn't have enough late and hung. PORK CHOP bumped at the start, raced wide along the backstretch, stalked the pace, had little left for the drive and finished evenly. K JS MADDOG bumped and was crowded at the start, got through inside leaving the turn and lacked a bid. TWISTGRIPS bumped at the start, stalked the pace, went seven wide leaving the turn and gave way. MATTY O'KEEFE was outrun.
