GENIUS PLAN was hustled along to vie between horses, inched away in the upper stretch and extended his lead under steady urging. NIGHT INVITE vied inside to the stretch, couldn't keep up and was no match for the winner. AGENT DUDLEY was void of early speed, angled in for the drive, drifted out in the stretch and got up for show. THAT'S HOW WE ROLL vied between horses to the turn, weakened and faded through the stretch. WINSLOSSESNLESSIONS lagged early, went five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. STRAIGHT WESTERN raced wide early, vied outside to the turn, fell back and finished evenly. RIO BRILLA broke slowly, saved ground, got through along the rail entering the stretch to get within striking distance but came up empty. ONE HOT BURN raced close to the pace, fell back on the turn but had nothing left for the drive. VOLLEYBALL LINDY raced inside and failed to respond. SHES A GO GO GIRL showed brief speed, was wide in the drive and did not threaten.
