BABE INCLUDED pressed the pace inside, challenged for the lead into the stretch, assumed command near the eighth pole, inched away for a short lead, was under pressure late and held well in a driving finish. CHOW MIEN raced mid pack inside, angled out on the turn, bid eight wide, closed under steady urging and gained late. NATAKA DEL SOUL was unhurried early, got through inside on the turn and closed well to earn show. LADY'S TASTE was in tight on the first turn, moved up between horses to assume command on the backstretch, led to mid stretch and faltered. BUDS N ROSES was unhurried early, got through along the rail on the second turn to get within striking distance and lacked the needed late rally. RED PEN LETTER was never far off the pace, went six wide entering the stretch, leveled off and faded from contention. BORREGO BABE stalked the pace, swung a bit wide leaving the turn, had little left for the drive and faded. HUM ALONG LIL had an awkward start and was crowded, raced evenly and failed to threaten. OUR KITTEN broke in, set the pace around the first turn and stopped after a half.
