CAPT. JOE BLOW set the early pace, saved ground on the turn, drew well clear into midstretch then maintained a safe margin to the wire. WALTZ TIME bobbed some at the start, moved out for the drive and finished well. TIE ROD between foes early, raced three wide on the turn and chased then was not good enough. PREFERRED YIELD stayed outside and lacked the needed response. IN TO THE WEST broke in, pressed the early issue between foes, raced along the inside through the lane and tired. UTAH ROCKET close up early, saved ground and weakened through the stretch. INEXCESSABEAU inside early and steadied slightly on the backstretch, dropped back and offered little thereafter.
