BEARS HOME RUN raced mid pack, rallied around the turn, lacked room in the upper stretch, angled out and closed well to be along in time. SUMMERTIME SAL stalked the pace, rallied four wide on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole, inched away for a short lead, led to deep stretch and was outclosed. EDGERIN J was unhurried early, bid inside entering the stretch, eased out for the drive and got up for show. BONBONI pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the second turn, dueled past the eighth pole and faltered. STORMY SEATTLE lagged, went three wide leaving the turn, failed to rally and was outrun. SKYSPY set the pace, responded when challenged, dueled past the eighth pole and faltered. MEDICINE CREEK was unhurried early, saved ground, lacked a bid and was outrun. BUFF DADDY raced mid pack, was through after a half, dropped back and had no further response. NOSIR raced close to the pace while racing outside, gave way entering the second turn, stopped and dropped back.
