GRAND MALTESE drew clear on the clubhouse turn, showed the way to the lane and widened into midstretch then maintained a safe margin to the wire. DA BOSS three wide turning for home, raced between rivals passing the eighth pole and finished well. GAMBLER BILL vied early then moved off the inside on the clubhouse turn and tracked, chased on the final bend then earned the show. VINDICATE IT well placed while saving ground, chased through the lane and needed more. MODERN GENTLEMAN saved ground and lacked the needed bid. DR. BILL PUTT trailed early and inside to the lane, lacked the needed rally. IRONICALLY in good position early, was asked for run on the final turn, drifted some during the stretch drive and lacked the needed response. STEP ASIDE CLYDE stayed outside and lacked a response.
