FANCEY ENDEVOR bumped at the start, tracked early inside, raced in the three path turning for home and reached the front in upper stretch then responded to pressure while edging clear. TAYLOR'S GIRL lodged a bid inside on the final turn, moved out into the lane and finished well. MAGUIRES BRIDGE crowded and hung wide into the clubhouse turn, moved in and advanced on the final turn, loomed a solid threat along the rail into midstretch then was not good enough. J J'S JUNCTION stumbled at the start, raced forwardly placed, was four wide turning for home and tired. TRIBAL LORE set the pace and tired in the drive. IRISH HAZEL V. lodged a four wide bid on the final turn and tired through the lane. FLAMES ABLAZIN bumped and hung wide into the clubhouse turn, lacked a rally. FAMILY SOUL was forced out into the clubhouse turn crowding rivals, chased to the far turn and tired. IRON FIREBALL bumped a rival at the start, came out into the clubhouse turn causing crowding, chased to the far turn and gave way then was vanned off.
