Footnotes

DELITEFUL DELPHA progressed inside, waited for room through the turn, was swung out three wide into the stretch, rallied under mostly hand urging, took over leaving the furlong marker and edged clear under a mild drive. ISLAND BRITE pressed STACYS FAN CLUB from just outside, made her move on the bend, took over near the quarter pole, was engaged by DELITEFUL DELPHA nearing the furlong marker, did not have enough late but was easily best of the rest. LA NATURALEZA in contention early from outside, was moved to the rail into the turn, passed tired ones once in the lane, moved outside STACYS FAN CLUB midstretch, drew off for third inside the final sixteenth of a mile and returned bleeding from the nostrils. SPOTLITE DANCER stumbled badly at the start, was rushed up between horses to prompt the pace four wide through the turn but weakened in the lane. STACYS FAN CLUB was hustled to a clear early lead, set the pace inside, was caught on the bend and faltered when set down for the stretch run. AVA'S FUTURE steadily faded five wide. SWEET JULIE broke alertly, was soon overtaken and gave way six wide on the turn. SILKY FLYER made a large leap from the gate, took a bit to get under control, was rushed up outside once into stride, advanced three wide on the turn but gave way behind a wall of horses in the stretch.
