**Footnotes**

HIPTOPIA set the pace, responded when challenged on the far turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed in a long drive under left handed urging. LUCKY ON THE RIVER bumped at the start, pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the second turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. MIX was unhurried mid pack, rallied around the far turn, bid four wide and got up late for show. HOPING FOR GOLD raced close to the pace outside, advanced to the second turn to loom a threat, leveled off and was outfinished for third. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE lagged while racing outside, bid six wide at the top of the stretch but had little left for the drive. OBSTRUCTION broke awkwardly to be off slowly and did not threaten in an even effort. HOLD THE PEACE passed tiring rivals. EUGENE'S BOY broke out and bumped at the start, stalked the pace to the second turn and tired. SHADOW JUSTICE had the rider check in tight quarters leaving the first turn, fell back and had no further response. TWIN CAM pressed the pace inside, had the rider check along the backstretch and to dropped back.
