**Footnotes**

BIG MAX outside on the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and finished gamely while up at the wire. AMBEKAY well placed and in the four path into the lane, battled head and head for the lead nearing the wire then just missed. SMART BLUES bumped at the start then came out, raced near the inside turning for home and finished willingly while between rivals late. JADEI KNIGHT established a clear margin in the run to the half mile pole, widened on the turn then weakened late. CYPRESS SAM near the rail passing the quarter pole and inside into the lane, lacked the needed late response. STARRY STRIVE broke in then in close to be away awkwardly, raced off the inside turning for home and offered a late gain. LEES DYNA MAN vied for the lead through the early stages, chased on the turn and tired. TOTAL FABRICATION saved ground while well placed and tired through the lane. BE THE WORM in a bit close at the start, raced near the rail on the turn and lacked a rally. LUCKY TIM came wide to the lane and lacked a rally. HOMETRADER weakened on the turn. WHO'S LIVELY was outrun.
