Footnotes

ROCKIN ON was sent up inside to gain the advantage nearing the end of the first quarter mile, drew clear when put to the whip in the stretch and was kept to task to the wire. SOCIETY CAT pressed the pace three to four wide between rivals, was no match for ROCKIN ON in the lane but unchallenged for the place. IT'SLONELYATHTHETOP broke alertly, raced in contention between rivals, improved position four wide on the turn, lacked a rally in the stretch but pulled clear for third late. DIAMONDSRBUENO raced in the second flight, backed up three wide on the bend, was cut off midstretch, altered out and lacked a late response. NOTHING LESS pressed ROCKIN ON from just outside for a half mile, could not keep up once in the lane and drifted out leaving midstretch. NORTON PEAK broke inward, bumping DOWN THE CREEK, was never a contender racing three to five wide but passed tired ones in the stretch. FOOLOFIT prompted the pace from outside, lost ground five wide on the bend and faltered when set down for the drive. BUCK'S SHAR failed to menace from not far off the rail. SHARPEN an early contender from inside, backed up nearing the turn, was angled out on the turn and faded in the lane. DOWN THE CREEK bumped and checked at the start, was never close. VARYKINO fractious in the gate, showed little from well off the rail.
