COVER MORE raced mid pack, bid five wide, closed steadily while drifting out a bit and got up late in a driving finish. CACTUS BREEZE moved up three wide to challenge for the lead, dueled to deep stretch, was outclosed but prevailed for place. SALADO TRIBE challenged between horses into the turn, dueled to deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. ENFORCER lagged early, went nine wide in the drive and closed well. ITALIAN STAR showed good early speed around the first turn, fell back to stalk inside, eased out for the drive, bid and hung. IN FOR A SONG was unhurried early, advanced along the rail into the turn, angled out for the drive, bid and came up empty. FAR FLUNG drew clear leaving the first turn, set the pace to the second turn, tired and faded through the stretch. NAVAJO KNIGHT was slow early, went seven wide in the drive, failed to rally and was not a threat. YO GERONIMO stalked the pace in a wide trip and stopped into the second turn.
