QUINTON'S GOLD stalked the pace, challenged for the lead five wide leaving the turn, dueled past the eighth pole and inched clear to prove best. DAN'S GROOVY set the pace, responded when challenged to duel past the eighth pole but couldn't match strides late. HENRY J raced mid pack in a steady effort, gained ground late and was best of the rest. ALENA'S TORNADO bid inside on the turn to bet within striking distance, angled out mid stretch and leveled off. DIPLOMATIC CORPS moved up between horses to stalk the pace and gave way mid stretch. RUB raced off the rail and failed to rally. THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN was not a factor. BETTER CHOICE stalked the pace inside and gave way mid stretch.
