NUCAYA saved ground while forwardly placed, shifted out nearing the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. I HAD A GOOD TIME pressed the pace outside, reached the front in deep stretch then was outfinished. POCKET PLEASER well placed and just off the inside turning for home, offered a gradual late gain. LASSO THE SUN saved ground turning for home and gained late. GENTLE RIDGE chased from the outside and lacked the needed late response. NINETY-NINE trailed then offered a belated gain outside. WE HAVE FUN raced in the three path into the lane and lacked the needed bid. BRITE RED BLOOMERS raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. TABITANGO lacked a rally. FAR BEYOND saved ground while setting the pace and faltered late then collapsed approaching the clubhouse turn, eventually getting back on her feet then was vanned off.
