WINE THIEF was unhurried early, dropped inside, got through along the rail on the turn, dueled through the stretch and proved best in a long drive. THREETIMESA WONDER set a pressured pace, responded when challenged to duel through the stretch under strong urging and was outfinished. GIBSON CRYSTAL raced close to the pace outside, went six wide leaving the turn and lacked the needed late response. GIACOMO GIRL was never far back, failed to rally and was not a threat. DOUBLE JAVA GIRL bumped at the start, pressed the pace to the turn, swung wide and gave way. MAIDA VALE was reluctant to load and failed to threaten in an even effort. NENA'S NINER showed speed to the turn and gave way. INDIANA NANA bobbled at the start while away well, fell back and lacked a bid. PRIDE DANCER (IRE) bumped at the start and failed to contend.
