Footnotes

MARK stalked the pace, rallied between horses entering the turn to challenge, dueled for the lead and drew off past the sixteenth pole. FREAKY set a pressured pace, responded when challenged to duel, faltered near the sixteenth pole and finished second best. CHIEF TYREE stalked the pace outside, went four wide entering the turn, leveled off in the drive but held safely for show. FOX BEGONE lagged outside, went nine wide at the top of the lane and offered a mild bid only. ELITE'S DREAM broke in the air, went ten wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. QUINNZ AWAY was never far off the pace, shifted out at the top of the lane, went seven wide and faded. COLLECTIVE CONCEPT had an inside trip and failed to menace in an even effort. TAHOE'S PRIZE broke slowly, raced inside to the turn, lacked a bid and was outrun. GOLONDRINA pressed the pace inside, was steadied into the turn and gave way.
