DANZING TRIBAL set the pace and held well in a driving finish. ABSOLUTELY COOL raced close to the pace, awaited room on the turn, bid four wide between horses, closed under strong urging, was gaining fast late and got up near the wire for place. TRIP THE GENERAL stalked inside, bid between horses at the top of the lane, went willingly to the wire to narrow the gap and was caught for second. EARNEDNEVERGIVEN stalked the pace, went five wide entering the stretch and lacked the needed late response. DONT MAKE ME MAD stalked the pace to the stretch, was unable to sustain his bid and faded from contention. BONBONI raced outside, went seven wide in the drive, lacked a rally and was not a threat. EL RANCHO bobbed a bit at the start and trailed the field under mild urging.
