SPEAKERS ACTION raced between horses to the turn, pressed the pace, wore down MIXED INTENT and got up in the final strides. MIXED INTENT set a pressured pace to the final strides and yielded grudgingly. ANNADU raced in the back while saving ground, angled out at the top of the lane, bid seven wide, found her best stride late and got up for show. LIL DISH raced close to the pace inside, got through along the rail on the turn, bid and hung. SHINE'N TIME raced in the middle of the pack, bid and hung. CARLOTTA DEL SOL was crowded and squeezed at the start and was not a factor. CHOCOLATE CALIENTE veered out at the start, pressed the pace three across, swung wide on the turn and gave way. DINA LIGHT pulled up and was vanned off.
