TAPADERO showed the way to the lane and responded gamely through the stretch while drawing out. RAN RAN RAN saved ground while well placed and finished willingly while second best. WOLFGANG in good position outside, was asked on the final turn, raced three wide turning for home and lacked the needed response. PROGRAM MANAGER raced four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. BITTER CREEK trailed early and just off the rail turning for home, offered a mild response. SUB DUE FORCE was along the rail when checked into the clubhouse turn, raced outside leaving the backstretch and was five wide passing the quarter pole then offered little in the drive. COBRAMATIC moved out on the backstretch and prompted the issue then weakened in the drive. WESTERN STRIDER raced five wide into the lane and lacked a rally. CURLYS DAY saved ground and lacked a bid.
