FOREST SUNRISE saved ground and vied for the lead, edged clear in the stretch then held a rival safe and was taken in hand at the wire. YODEL ME HOME broke out, raced between rivals on the turn and pressed then continued on willingly. NOBLE CAVALIER vied for the lead between foes into the turn, raced in the three path and needed more. LUCK OF THE DEVIL pressed four deep on the turn and also needed more. JUST SAY IT raced in the five path entering the lane and lacked the needed rally. WILDEST PASSION a bit reluctant loading, raced six wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MAGIC PARTNER raced off the rail on the turn and offered little in the drive. HIGH REGARDS broke slowly, saved ground and lacked a rally.
